An anomaly in a region where most producers source their grapes, Casa de Santa Eufemia is a grower port estate, founded in 1894 by Bemardo Rodrigues de Carvalho. Located on the left bank of the Douro Valley in one of the oldest demarcated wine regions in the world, Santa Eufemia is now run by the sibling duo, Pedro and Lucia Carvalho. Pedro and Lucia cultivate varietals nearing extinction in Portugal, including Bastardo, Mourisco Tinto, Tinta Amarela, Tinta Barroca and Tinta Carvalha. In addition to the preservation of these grapes and others, the Carvalhos have identified sub-plots within their vineyards, each known by the duo to produce specific colors, aromatics and structure, so each sub-plot can be designated to a particular Tawny port. The 10 year Tawny has a deep tawny hue with aromas of dried fruits, slight floral and ripe fruit aromas and orange flower. It has a delicate style, balancing freshness and dryness. There is a medium level of acidity and lightness, finishing with a kiss of sweetness. The Ruby has aromas and flavors of mature red fruits and jam; distinctive of the Touriga Nacional grape varietal. Both Casa de Santa Eufemia's Ruby Port and 10 Year Tawny are a blend of Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Tinta Barroca, Tinto Cão, Tinta Amarela, Tinta Francisca.

This cuvée is a collaboration between Chandra Kurt and oenologist Madeleine Gay made from Pinot Noir and Gamay planted on limestone and slate soils in the heart of the Valais near Sion. Based in Zürich, Chandra Kurt is Switzerland's foremost wine writer, educator, and critic. She has authored more than 20 books on wine. She studied at the Universities of Zürich and Lausanne and the Institute of Masters of Wine in London. Her wines are an extension of her desire to understand the interaction of terroir and variety and to make wines that are not only a pleasure to drink but reveal something unique and special about the wine styles of her home. Dôle is the local name for a blend of Pinot Noir and Gamay, and Chandra's version is a lithe and aromatic blend of 65% Pinot Noir and 35% Gamay. While neither of these varieties are indigenous to the Valais, they represent 40% of the vines planted here where they take well to the warm south and southwest-facing limestone and slate slopes above the Rhône.

Cook's Flat Reserve represents Smith-Madrone's uncompromising pursuit of perfection in winemaking. Each bottle is numbered and tissue-wrapped with a copy of the U.S. Land Office patent which was signed by President Chester Arthur, granting ownership of the land to George Cook. That original document hangs in the winery and is an important part of the Smith-Madrone history. The name was chosen in tribute to George Cook, the first owner of the property and the person who originally planted the vines at the estate in the 1880s. The 2019 is a blend of 90% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Cabernet Franc and aged for 18 months in 100% new French oak.

On the palate, delicate layers of soft tannin twist and turn like an artist's brush stroke, revealing flavors of dark plum, fig, earth, leather and cocoa. The lingering finish is transcendent, where lush fruit and minerality caress the senses. In its entirety, 'Rindo' is a wine with aging potential, begging to be enjoyed now." -Kenzo Estate

The Clare Valley is one of the major wine regions in South Australia and home to some of the most awarded wineries in the country. It's also one of Australia's oldest wine-producing areas, dating back to the 1850s. The Koerner brothers are making some of the best expressions in the region. Their winemaking philosophy is minimal intervention, a hands off approach with the goal to make wines that reflect their place in the world. An understanding of terroir and the individual varieties enables The Koerner Brothers to produce unique wines using nothing but the grapes, organic practices in the vineyards and a small amount of sulfur. The result is light, fresh, textured and well structured, easy drinking wines. One of the most special wines in our collection. Our Wine Director, Dana Andersen, worked on the vineyard and winery teams at Château Lynch-Bages during the 2019 vintage and credits the estate with having a large impact on her career in the wine industry. She feels lucky to have sourced this wine to be able to offer it to guests at Ember & Oak. "June was a pivotal month for the 2019 vintage. The first two weeks were quite unsettled and scorching temperatures followed resulting in the vineyard undergoing severe hydric stress. The Bordeaux region received the equivalent of six months of rainfall, from the end of October until the beginning of December 2018. Hugely beneficial to soil, those rainfalls replenished water reserves. Harvest began on September 23rd with the fully mature Merlot plants, and took place over five days with four parcels of Cabernet Franc being the last to be harvested. Pickers continued with nine days of Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot picking. Harvesting ended on October 9th. Echo de Lynch-Bages 2019, the second wine of the estate displays a deep, brilliant robe. On the nose, the fruit is expressive with glimpses of a lovely freshness. With characteristic finesse and generous palate, its tannic structure is delicately enhanced by intense notes of fresh red fruits such as redcurrants or raspberries." -Château Lynch-Bages
